This agency conducted an investigation into alledged sexual misconduct of Gregory A. Benson, a unit leader of Ship #601, B.S.A.

During the course of the investigation, a statement was obtained from a twelve year old member of Ship #601.

The statement was to the effect, that during a unit outing in Tillamook County during January of 1979, the boy was sexually molested by Gregory A. Benson.

Subsequent to this statement, Gregory A. Benson left the scout program.

At that point, it was decided that prosecuting the case would not be in the best interest of the juvenile boy.

Therefore, the case has been filed without adjudication.
